

2011 adidas Auckland Marathon - Road Closure and Parking Restriction Schedule

Devonport

- King Edward Parade between Victoria Road and Church Street will be closed between 3.00am and 7.30am.
- Parking restrictions will apply to both sides of King Edward Parade from Victoria Road to Mays Street.
- Church Street and Vauxhall Road will be closed from 5.00am to 7.45am.
- Hamana Street and Seacliffe Avenue will be closed from 5.00am to 7.45am.
- Winscombe Street will be closed from 4.30am to 7.45am.

Devonport/Takapuna

- Lake Road eastern side between Winscombe Street and Esmonde Road will be partially closed from 4.30am to 8.15am. A one-way coned system will operate in this area.

Takapuna

- Lake Road western side from Esmonde Road to Bracken Avenue will be fully closed from 4.30am to 8.15am.
- Bracken Avenue between Lake Road and Burns Avenue will be closed from 4.30am to 8.15am.
- Burns Avenue from Bracken Avenue to Esmonde Road will be closed from 4.30am to 8.20am.
- Burns Avenue western side from Bracken Avenue to Anzac Avenue will be partially closed from 4.30am to 8.20am. A one-way system will operate in this area.
- Anzac Street, south side from Burns Ave to Taharoto Road, Taharoto Road west side, from Anzac Road to Northcote Road, Northcote Road south side from Taharoto Road to Lake Road, will be partially closed from 4.30am to 8.30am. A two-way coned system will operate in these areas

Birkenhead/Northcote

- Northcote Road south side from Taharoto Road to Lake Road will be partially closed from 4.30am to 8.45am. A two-way coned system will operate in this area
- Lake Road south side from Northcote Road to Raleigh and Exmouth Roads will be partially closed from 4.30am to 9.00am. A two-way coned system will operate in this area

- Lake Road south side from Raleigh and Exmouth Roads to Onewa Road will be partially closed from 4.30am to 9.00am. A one way coned system will operate in this area.
- Onewa Road between Queen Street and Sylvan Avenue will be partially closed from 4.30am to 9.30am. 1 way cone system will operate in this area
- Queen Street south side from Onewa to Stafford Road. A one way coned system will operate in this area from 4.30am to 9.30am.
- Stafford Road will be closed from Queen Street to the Motorway from 4.45am to 9.30am.

Motorway and Harbour Bridge

- The southbound-on ramp and the northbound-off ramp at the Northcote Motorway Interchange will be closed from 4.00am to 10.30am.
- Curran Street on-ramp Northbound will be closed from 4.00am to 10.30am.
- Stafford Road off-ramp Northbound will be closed from 4.00am to 10.30am.
- Onewa Road off-ramp Northbound will be closed from 4.00am to 10.30am.
- Northbound clip on lanes (Lanes 1 and 2) of the Auckland Harbour Bridge will be closed from 4.00am to 10.30am. All other lanes on the bridge will be open to traffic.

St Marys Bay / Westhaven

- Curran Street between Jervious Road and Westhaven Drive will be closed from 4.00am to 11.00am.
- Sarsfield Street between Hamilton Road and Shelly Beach Road will be closed from 4.00am to 11.00am.
- Westhaven Drive from Curran Street to Beaumont Street will be fully closed from 4.00am to 11.00am.
- Parking restrictions will apply during the event to both sides of Sarsfield Street between Curran Street and Shelly Beach Road and the southern side of Emmett Street from Curran Street to Shelly Beach Road.

Tank Farm / Victoria Park / Viaduct Basin

- Beaumont Street from Fanshawe Street to Jellicoe Street will be fully closed from 3.00am to 11.30am.
- Hamer Street and Brigham Streets from Jellicoe Street will be fully closed from 3.00am to 11.30am.

- Daldy Street from Madden Street to Jellicoe Street will be fully closed from 3.00am to 11.30am.
- Daldy Street from Fanshawe Street to Pakenham Street will be fully closed from 3.00am to 11.30am.
- Madden Street from Beaumont Street to Halsey Street will be fully closed from 3.00am to 11.30am.
- Pakenham Street from Beaumont Street to Halsey Street will be fully closed from 3.00am to 11.30am. A one-way system for NZBus will apply.
- Gaunt Street from Beaumont Street to Halsey Street will be fully closed from 3.00am to 11.30am. A one-way system for NZBus only will apply.
- Halsey Street from Jellicoe Street to Gaunt Street will be fully closed from 9.00pm Saturday 29 October to 11.30am Sunday 30 October.
- Halsey Street from Gaunt Street to Fanshawe Street will be closed from 9.00pm Saturday 29 October to 1pm Sunday 30 October.
- Fanshawe Street (city bound) from Beaumont Street to Halsey Street will be closed from 3.00am to 3.00pm.
- Fanshawe Street (west bound) from Beaumont Street to Halsey Street will be closed from 1.00am to 3.00pm.
- Viaduct Harbour Drive from Halsey Street to Customs Street West will be closed from 8.00pm Saturday 29 October to 1.00pm Sunday 30 October.
- Parking restrictions will apply during the event to:
 - the east side of Beaumont Street from Fanshawe Street south for 150m
 - the west side of Beaumont Street between Westhaven Drive and Jellicoe Street;
 - Hamer Street, west/north side between Jellicoe and Brigham Streets;
 - Brigham Street, east side between Hamer and Jellicoe Streets;
 - Jellicoe Street north side between Brigham Street and Halsey Street
 - Halsey Street, east side between Jellicoe and Fanshawe Streets;
 - Gaunt Street, both sides between Daldy Street and Halsey Streets;
 - Halsey Street, both sides between Victoria and Fanshawe Streets; and
 - Viaduct Harbour Avenue, both sides between Halsey Street and Customs Street West.

CBD / Mechanics Bay

- Customs Street West from Viaduct Harbour Drive to Lower Hobson Street will be fully closed from 8.00pm Saturday 29 October to 1.00pm Sunday 30 October.

- Sturdee Street northern lands from Market Lane to Custom Street West will be closed from 3.00am to 1.00pm.
- Lower Hobson Street western side from Sturdee Street to Quay Street will be fully closed from 3.00am to 11.30am.
- Quay Street northern lane and car park lane from Lower Hobson Street to Tamaki Drive will be closed from 4.00am to 11.30am.
- Parking restrictions will apply during the event to:
 - Customs Street West, both sides from Viaduct Harbour Ave to Lower Hobson Street
 - Lower Hobson Street, western side between Custom Street West Street and Quay Street
 - Quay Street, north side, between Lower Hobson Street and The Strand

The Bays (City side)

- Tamaki Drive northern lane and car park lane from The Strand to Ngapipi Road will be fully closed from 5.00am to 11.30am. A one way coned system (southern lanes) will operate.
- Tamaki Drive from Ngapipi Road to Maheke Street will be fully closed from 4.00am to 11.30am.
- Parking restrictions will apply during the event to:
 - Tamaki Drive, north side, between The Strand and St Heliers Bay Road (prior to Pedestrian Crossing)
 - Tamaki Drive, south side, between Ngapipi Road to Okahu Street
